Purpose

The organization supports horticulture and horticultural related projects and those groups and individuals that are involved or directly related.

How to Apply

To apply for a grant you must submit a one page letter of intent to Colorado Garden Foundation offices by noon on August 30^{th.} This one page single-sided letter should include a description of the project, the overall budget along with the amount of funding requested from Colorado Garden Foundation. You can provide as much additional information as you'd like as long as it fits in the one page. The letter can be EMAILED as an attachment to the above email address. Grant letters submitted that are longer than one page will be rejected. Selected applicants will be requested to submit complete details by October 31st. Attachments related to the application are then accepted. In the application, applicants must include how Colorado Garden Foundation will be recognized for the grant award. The initial letter MUST include a contact name, address, phone, email address and your Federal ID Number. Grants are selected by early December with distribution in the spring of the following year.

Restrictions

Funding is limited to nonprofit and governmental agencies. No funding for political organizations. Grant requests are restricted to a minimum of \$15,000 and a maximum of \$75,000. Capital and matching grants are the targeted projects, while other programs/projects for support and research will also be considered.
